Marrakech: nasire

Endlich ist es so weit: Das Schweizer Taschenlabel nasire, welches bisher fast nur online aktiv war, hat seinen ersten Laden in Marrakesch eröffnet. Die Kunden können die Lederwaren nun direkt im Herstellungsland, im Haus Shtatto, betrachten und kaufen. Das Interior wurde vom Schweizer Architekten Patrick Meyer gestaltet. Dabei wurden ausschliesslich lokale Materialien wie etwa marokkanischer Marmor verwendet. Das Label bleibt somit seinem Credo «Designed in Zurich, produced in Marrakech» durchs Band treu.

Finally! Swiss bag label nasire, whose products were previously almost only available online, has its first shop, in Marrakech. So customers can buy these leather items in the country where they are made. The shop, which is in the Shtatto House, features an appealing interior by Swiss architect Patrick Meyer for which only local materials such as Moroccan marble have been used. Which keeps the label true to its creed: “Designed in Zurich, produced in Marrakech.”

Der Name Shtatto bedeutet Mehlsieb – früher wurden hier solche hergestellt.

The name “shtatto” means “flour sifter” – these were once made there.

Die 86 Zimmer dieses neuen Londoner Boutiquehotels wurden von Designer Michaelis Boyd gestaltet und reflektieren die reiche filmische Geschichte dieses Kinodistrikts mitten im West End. Auch wenn Touristenattraktionen wie Londons bekannter Leicester Square oder der Piccadilly Circus gleich um die Ecke liegen, verspricht das Victory House dank gut isolierten Räumen einen erholsamen und ruhigen Schlaf – in herrlich bequemen Betten!



The 86 rooms of this new London boutique hotel, which are the work of designer Michaelis Boyd, reflect the rich movie history of its surroundings, the cinema district in the heart of the West End. And while tourist spots such as Leicester Square or Piccadilly Circus are all just around the corner, the Victory House Hotel is excellently insulated to ensure a sound and restful sleep – in fabulously comfortable beds!
